Subject :- Advisory regarding operation of 10 CA & 10 CC clauses in the agreement.
Reference:- Issue number Four raised at Technical Committee Meeting on 04/11/2019


Instances have been noticed by the directorate that while operating escalation clauses in 10 CA & 10 CC in agreements various lapses have been made resulting in over payments to the contractors. The lapses noticed are as under:-

1. While working out the escalation under clause 10 CC, the component of cement, steel reinforcement bars, Structural Steel, POL etc. are being added while these are covered under clause- 10 CA.
2. The operation of 10 CA is not being done properly when rate of materials included in 10 CA are decreasing, requiring recovery under clause 10 CA.
3. Incorrect pre-determination of all components in the NIT for application of clause 10 CC, the percentage determination of civil components of materials covered under clause 10 CA i.e. Cement, Steel reinforcement bars, Structural Steel, POL etc. NIT approving authorities are not taking due care while working out the percentage for the component of materials.
4. Application of price indices for calculation of 10 CA for materials Cement, Steel reinforcement bars, Structural Steel, POL etc. other than the indices as issued under the authority of Director General, CPWD.
5. Application of price Indices for calculation for 10 CC other than the indices as issued under the authority of Director General, CPWD.
6. The zonal Chief Engineers are not issuing the base prices for Cement, Steel reinforcing bars, structural steel, POL and other materials covered under clause 10 CA on regular basis.

All field units are accordingly advised to be careful in operation of clause 10 CA & 10 CC to avoid these lapses, it is advised to incorporate following line in the check list of R/A bill and final bill to ensure the recovery on account of escalation.


"Whether escalation under clause 10 C & 10 CA or 10 CC as applicable as per schedule "F" of NIT is operated- yes/ No".
