Sub:- Handling of disciplinary cases by the Superintending Engineer level officers.

It has come to the notice of this office that while handling the disciplinary cases, the inquiry reports and representations of charged officers are not examined holistically by the disciplinary authorities at the level of SEs. Further, many violations of CVC guidelines and CCS (CCA) Rules are also noticed. This is unnecessarily involving protracted correspondence and delay in the final disposal of the disciplinary cases.

2. In order to avoid above discrepancies, it has been decided that as soon the inquiry reports or representations of the charged officers are received by the disciplinary authorities, then the same are to be sent to Vigilance Unit for examination and comments. The decision on imposition of penalty or otherwise will be taken by the disciplinary authorities only after the receipt of the comments of the Vigilance Unit.

3. It will be applicable to only those cases, in which investigation is conducted by the Vigilance Unit, CPWD and draft charge memo was sent to the disciplinary authority.

4. This issues with the approval of Chief Vigilance Officer, CPWD.
