**CIRCULAR**


Para 22.1.3(3) of CPWD Works Manual 2014 provides for periodic review of Register of Security deposit by the divisional officers to keep a close watch on the delays in refund of security deposit to the contractors.

While examining a case, it is revealed that deposit register was not maintained in the Division which disabled mechanism of monitoring of release of security deposit of the contractor as per para 22.2(3) and 22.6 of CPWD works Manual 2014 and led to delay in release of SD.

In absence of the deposit register, provisions of para 22.2(3) and 22.6 of CPWD, Work Manual 2014 may get overlooked.


All Chief Engineer are instructed to ensure that the deposit register is duly maintained and it is regularly monitored by all concerned in Divisions in their jurisdiction.
