Sub:- Recommendations for issue of circular to all field units to include more (more than 3) number of approved makes in the NIT.

(Systematic Improvement Recommendations No.21/2017).

Sir,

During investigation of a complaint it has been observed that 3 makes of Inverter, viz., Servocon/IPC/Power Line were stipulated in all the NITs and all the orders were placed on M/s. Sanbro Power Control Systems, an authorised dealer of Servocon brand on L1 basis.

CVC guidelines stipulates minimum benchmark of 3 approved makes to be specified in the NIT. But, in cases where the items are of general nature and large number of quality manufacturers are available in the field, then restriction to only 3 approved makes in the NIT stifles the competition as it is excluding many good quality manufacturers from the competition.

To increase competition and to ensure economic and competitive price, it would be appropriate to include more approved makes in the NIT (more than 3).

DG, CPWD vide noting dated 23.10.2017 has directed to issue an Office Memorandum by CE (CSQ) Electrical to avoid above unacceptable situation.

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I have been directed to request you to please issue a circular to all field units giving directions to include more (more than 3) number of approved makes in the NIT, while procuring items of general nature for which a large number of good manufacturers are available in the market.
