OFFICE ORDER No.234 of 2006

The Director General of Works, CPWD is pleased to promote the under mentioned Junior Engineers (Civil) to the grade of Assistant Engineers (Civil) in the Central Civil Engineering Group 'B' Services on ad-hoc basis in the pay scale of Rs. 6500-10500 with effect from the date they take over the post of Assistant Engineers (Civil) for a period of one year or until further orders whichever is earlier and subject to the final outcome of the Writ Petition pending in the Delhi High Court WP @ 840/2003 in the matter of Gurbaaj Singh and others versus Union of India and others etc. as informed by EC-I section vide their office order No. 75, 97 and 120 dated 21st April, 12th May and 31st May 2006 respectively.

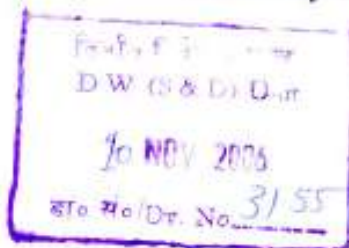
2. This ad-hoc promotion will not confer any right on him to any claim either for regular appointment as Assistant Engineer (Civil) or for determining seniority in the grade of Assistant Engineer (Civil) or any incidental benefits of regular promotion.

3. The Director General of Works CPWD is further pleased to decide the following transfer /posting in the grade of Asstt. Engineer (Civil) with immediate effect in public interest.

The Executive Engineers/Superintending Engineers should ensure that no vigilance/disciplinary case is either pending or contemplated against any of the Officers being promoted on ad-hoc basis now before they are relieved to take up the post of Asstt. Engineers (Civil.). It may also be ensured that no penalty has been awarded to them, which may stand in the way of promotion. In such event, the fact may be brought immediately to the notice of this Office. A certificate to this effect may also be sent by the controlling officers along with the relieving order of




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the officers on promotion. The officer-in-charge under whom they are working may ensure that the concerned officer may be relieved within 30 days from the date of issue of posting order by respective ADG without waiting for the substitute. Their orders of promotion on ad-hoc basis are liable to be treated to have been withdrawn on the expiry of stipulated period of 30 days. They should join immediately on relief.

5. The Officers under orders of posting and transfers should immediately proceed to their respective places after having been relieved by their superior officers and send two copies of TR-1 Form with their names in capital letters to the Section Officer, EC-III Section giving reference to these orders. The Officer-in-Charge, under whom they are working should ensure that the concerned officers are relieved immediately without waiting for the services of their substitutes.

6. The officers listed in para 2 above on promotion on ad-hoc basis may exercise their option under FR 22-1 (a) (i) for pay fixation within a period of one month from the date they assume the charge of the higher post. However, those who have already got the higher scale as personal to them will neither be entitled to re-fixation of pay nor for exercising the option on promotion. Further, those who have availed ACP Scheme and exercised the option for pay fixation under FR-22-1(a) (i), will not be entitled for exercising this option again on their regular promotion.


