OFFICE ORDER No. 12 of 2008

The Director General of Works, CPWD is pleased to appoint the following Junior Engineers (Civil) to officiate as Assistant Engineer (Civil) in the Central Civil Engineering Group 'B' Services temporarily **on ad-hoc basis** in the scale of pay of Rs. 6500-200-10500 from the date they take over the charge of the post of Assistant Engineer (Civil) for a period of one year or until further orders whichever is earlier and subject to the final outcome of the Writ Petitions pending in the Delhi High Court W.P.(C)840/2003 in the matter of Shri Gurbaaj Singh and others versus Union of India and others, etc. as informed by EC-I Section vide their Office Order No. 74, 99 and 122 dated 21st April, 20th May and 31st May 2006 respectively.

2. This ad-hoc promotion will not confer any right on them to any claim either for regular appointment as Assistant Engineer (Civil) or for determining seniority in the grade of Assistant Engineer (Civil) or any incidental benefits of regular promotion.

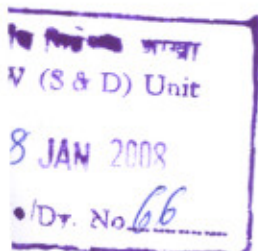

The Executive Engineers/Superintending Engineers should ensure that no vigilance/disciplinary case is either pending or contemplated against any of the Officer being promoted now on ad-hoc basis before they are relieved to take up the post of Asstt. Engineers (Civil) on promotion. It may also be ensured that no penalty has been awarded to them, which may stand in the way of promotion on ad-hoc basis. In such event, the fact may be brought immediately to the notice of this Office. A certificate to this effect may also be sent by the controlling officers along with the relieving order of the officers on promotion. The officer-in-charge under whom they are working may ensure that the concerned officer may be relieved within 30 days from the date of issue of posting order by respective ADG without waiting for the substitute. Their orders of promotion on ad-hoc basis are liable to be treated to have been withdrawn on the expiry of stipulated period of 30 days. They should join immediately on relief.

4. The Officers under orders of posting and transfers should immediately proceed to their respective places after having been relieved by their superior officers and send two copies of TR-1 Form with their names in capital letters to the Section Officer, EC-III Section giving reference to these orders. The Officer-in-Charge, under whom they are working should ensure that the concerned officers are relieved immediately without waiting for the services of their substitutes.

5. The officers listed in para 3 above on promotion may exercise their option under FR 22-I (a) for pay fixation within a period of one month from the date they assume the charge of the higher post. However, those who have already got the higher scale as personal to them will neither be entitled to exercise fixation of pay nor for exercising the option on promotion. Further, those who have availed the FR-22-I Scheme and exercised the option for pay fixation under FR-22-1(a) (i), will not be entitled to exercise this option again on their ad-hoc promotion.
