**OFFICE ORDER NO 223 of 2006**

The Director General of Works, CPWD is pleased to appoint the following Junior Engineer (Elect) to officiate as Assistant Engineer (Elect.) in the Central Elect Engineering Group 'B' Services temporarily on ad-hoc basis in the scale of Rs. 6500-10500 from the date he takes over the charge of the post of Assistant Engineer (Elect) for a period of one year or until further orders whichever is earlier and subject to the final outcome of the Writ Petitions pending in the Delhi High Court W.P. (C)840/2003 in the matter of Gurbaj Singh and others versus Union of India and others etc. as informed by EC.I Section vide their Office Order No. 74, 99 and 122 dated 21<sup>st</sup> April, 12<sup>th</sup> May and 31<sup>st</sup> May 2006 respectively.

2. This ad-hoc promotion will not confer any right on him to any claim either for regular appointment as Assistant Engineer (Elect.) or for determining seniority in the grade of Assistant Engineer (Elect.) or any incidental benefits of regular promotion.

4. The Executive Engineers/Superintending Engineers should ensure that no vigilance/disciplinary case is either pending or contemplated against the above official being promoted now on ad-hoc basis before he is relieved to take up the post of Asstt. Engineers (Elect.) on promotion. It may also be ensured that no penalty has been awarded to him, which may stand in the way of promotion on ad-hoc basis. In such event, the fact may be brought immediately to the notice of this Office. A certificate to this effect may also be sent by the controlling officers along with the relieving order of the officer on promotion. The officer-in-charge under whom he is working may ensure that the concerned officer may be relieved within 30 days from the date of issue of posting order by respective ADG without waiting for the substitute. His order of promotion on ad-hoc basis is liable to be treated to have been withdrawn on the expiry of stipulated period of 30 days. He should join immediately on relief.

5. The Officer under order of posting and transfer should immediately proceed to his place of posting after having been relieved by his superior officers and send two copies of TR-1 Form with his name in capital letter to the Section Officer, EC-III Section giving reference to this order. The Officer-in-Charge, under whom he is working should ensure that the concerned officer is relieved immediately without waiting for the services of his substitute.

6. The officer listed in para 2 above on promotion may exercise his option under FR 22-1 (a) (i) for pay fixation within a period of one month from the date he assume the charge of the higher post. However, if he has already got the higher scale as personal to him will neither be entitled to re-fixation of pay nor for exercising the option on promotion. Further, if he has availed ACP Scheme and exercised the option for pay fixation under FR-22-1(a) (i), will not be entitled for exercising this option again on his ad-hoc promotion.


