Sub: Concession to unemployed Engineers and their Societies in respect of award of works in CPWD

- 1.0 The following concessions shall be admissible to the following category of engineers :-
- 1.1 In case of those who have lost their job provided they have not resigned voluntarily, not dismissed or removed from service on the grounds of misconduct, the concession in this category shall be applicable upto 5 years of the date of having been thrown out of job. A certificate from the last employer will be necessary to prove eligibility.
- 1.2 In the case of others those having completed their degree or diploma and have not been able to secure employment with regular salary, a registration certificate from the employment exchange shall also be produced on demand.
- 2.0 Concessions
- 2.1 Award of works upto Rs. 2,00,000/- (by SE) and Rs. 1,00,000/- (by EE) without call of tenders / quotations at rates not exceeding current market rate provided the same are certified as reasonable by the officers of CPWD to be decided by the accepting authority.
- 2.2 No earnest money is to be taken if the work is awarded on Work order Form PWD-11 and PWD 11-A.

No earnest money need to be taken from such unemployed engineers or their societies. However security Deposit shall be deducted as applicable.
- 2.3 This concession is exclusive of works under taken on PWD11&11-A i.e. works undertaken under normal powers delegated to CPWD officers for work orders as per OM No. DGW/MAN/72 dt.21.08.01.

This issues with the Concurrence of Finance Division of M/o UD&PA vide their U.O letter No. W/4/2001/VIP/M/DGW/Vol. III dt. 19.02.03 and the above said concession to unemployed engineers and their societies is extended upto 29.02.04.
