In view of the rise in the cost indices for construction m2. of buildings and the related materials, the Commission has been considering to raise the monetary limit of the works to be reported by the Organisation to the CIEs. It has been decided that henceforth all the Organisations may include only those works in the return to be submitted to the CTE's Organisation whose accepted/tender value exceeds Rs 1 arore for Civil works, Rs.15 lacs for Electrical works Rs. 2 lacs for Horticulture works. The works while ichepted/ tendered value is less than these limits need not be included in the returns.
