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Sir,

I am directed to refer to your U.O. No. 14/4/85-A&C (DGW), dated 10th March, 1988, on the subject cited above and to say that the President is pleased to further extend the concessions granted in this Ministry's letter No. 28012/1/76-W.4 dated 13.4.1978 (copy enclosed) to unemployed Engineers and their societies in respect of award of works in CPWD upto 28.2.1989 subject to the conditions stipulated in this Ministry's letter of even number dated 11th April, 1985 (Copy enclosed). The concessions were last extended upto 28.2.1988 vide this Ministry's letter of even number dated 20th March, 1987.

2. Efforts should be made by the Chief Engineers to popularise the scheme so that the contracts go to technically qualified unemployed Engineers.

3. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Division (W&S) vide their U.O. No. 554/ &S/D.II(a)/28 dated 16.3.1988.

Sub : Award of works to unemployed engineers and their
societies in the CPWD.

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Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated the 12/19.3.76 and to say that President has been pleased to extend further the following concessions to unemployed engineers or the registered cooperative societies formed by them in respect of award of works in the CPWD upto 31.3.79.

- (I) If no registered labour co-operative society is forthcoming to take up any particular work of works costing Rs. 20,000/- the unemployed engineers or their societies may be given the same concessions as are admissible to their registered labour cooperative for award of such works, namely,
- (a) Award of works upto Rs.20,000/- without call of tenders at rates not exceeding current market rate to be decided by the accepting authority.
 - (b) No earnest money is to be taken if the work is awarded on form PWD II or II-A.
 - (c) No security money is taken if (on Account) payment are not desired.
- (II) (a) For works costing Rs. 20,001/- to Rs.1 lakh, a price preference upto 3% may be given to unemployed engineers or their societies.
- (b) No earnest money need to be taken from such unemployed engineers or their societies. They should, however be required to give necessary bank guarantees.

The terms unemployed engineers means unemployed diploma holders or graduate engineers to recognised Institutions. The concessions shall be admissible to the following category of engineers:-

- (a) In the case of those who have lost their job provided they had not resigned voluntarily, not dismissed or removed from service on the grounds of misconduct. The concession in this category shall be applicable upto 5 years of the date of having been thrown out of job. A certificate from the last employer will be necessary to prove eligibility.
- (b) In the case of others those having completed their degree or diploma and have not secured or not been able to secure employment with regular salary.

Sub : Concession to unemployed engineers and their societies
in respect of award of work in the CPWD.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your U.O. No. 14(4)/85-AdC (DGW) dated 12.3.85 on the above subject and to say that the President is pleased to extend further the concession granted in this Ministry's letter No. 28012(1)/76-W.4 dated 13.4.78 to unemployed engineers and their societies in respect of award of work in CPWD upto 20.2.1986, subject to the following conditions:-

1. The concessions should be available only for a period of 5 years from the date of retrenchment or acquiring of degree/diploma.
2. The unemployed engineers should be registered with employment exchange and should not have declined a reasonable offer of employment.
3. The concessions should be available for 3 works only. After executing three works, the engineer should get himself registered with this Deptt.
4. While submitting application for purchase of tender papers the unemployed engineer should file documentary evidence in support of 1 above and a written statement in respect of 2 & 3.
2. Efforts should be made by the Chief Engineer's to popularise the scheme so that the contracts go to technically qualified unemployed engineers.
3. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance (W&E Unit) vide their U.O. No. 829/W&E/D.III(a)/85 dated 3.4.85.
