
Subject:- Issue of tenders for demolition and construction.

Consequent on the acceptance of the recommendations of the Technical Committee constituted in the light of Para 15.7 of the 143rd Report (1988-89) of the Public Accounts Committee (Eighth Lok Sabha) on Crash Housing Programmes, it has been decided by the Government that the following procedure should be followed for engagement of contractors for demolition and construction of buildings:-

- i) Separate contract for dismantlement and disposal of structures may be resorted to when there is enough time available after receipt of approval to dispose of these structures and receipt of Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction for reconstruction.
- ii) Where exigency and urgency of work so demands, combined tender for demolition of building and construction of new building may be resorted to. The decision may be taken at the level not lower than that of the Chief Engineer of the Central Public Works Department who should also record reason due to which combined tender for demolition of the old building and construction of the new building is to be invited.

2. Order for amendment of Para 128 (ii) of CPWD Code are being issued separately.

3. These instructions may be strictly adhered to.
