Subject: Enlistment Rules – 2005- amendment to appendix 34 of CPWD Works Manual 2007.

In partial modification to rules of enlistment of contractors in CPWD, 2005, as given at appendix 34 of CPWD Works Manual 2007, paras 4.2, 7 and 19.0 of the Rules are hereby amended with the immediate effect.

Elect. Installation - In place of two works of five lacs each, it can be one work of Rs. 15 lacs. c) Class III horticulture – In place of two works of Rs. 2 lacs each, it can be one work of Rs. 6 lacs.
