
Criteria for sale of tenders , restricted call of tenders, pre-qualification of contractors and pre-qualification documents for CPWD works -modification regarding

As per the provision of para (E) at page 4 of circular OM No. DGW/MAN/65 dt. 4.4.01, the contractor should have a solvency of the amount equal to 40 % of the estd. cost of the work . Whereas Table I of Financial soundness of OM DGW/CON/ 153 dt. 26.03.01- Rules for enlistment of contractors in CPWD, 2001 specifies solvency of Rs. 2.00 crores for tendering limit of Rs. 5.00 crores for class I category contractor(s).

The following amendments / changes as under are hereby made in the OM No. DGW/MAN/65 dt. 04.04.2001 :-

Para (E) and para 2(d) of the Invitation to pre-qualify and 7.5 of Section -II

Existing	Modified
Solvency certificate. The contractor Should have a solvency of the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost of the work.	1.0 CPWD registered contractors 1.1 Class I category only: 1.1.1 Estd. cost upto Rs. 5.0 Crores - No solvency required 1.1.2 Estd. cost beyond Rs. 5.0 Crores - Solvency of the amount equal to 40% of the estd. cost of the work is required.
	2.0 Non CPWD Contractor all class & category: - The contractor should submit a solvency certificate of the amount equal to 40% of the estd. cost of the work.
