OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject : Amendments to paras 7.25 & 8.7 of CPWD Manual Vol II, 1988 Edition.

The paras 7.25 & 8.7 of the above CPWD Manual Vol II, are, hereby, amended as below:-

Para 7.25 : All items of work in a project irrespective of their cost, shall be measured and recorded by the Junior Engineer incharge of the work except for the following items which shall be measured and recorded by the Assistant Engineer/Assistant Executive Engineer incharge of the work.

1. All hidden items as defined in para 7.27.2.
2. Items of marble work and /or of any other stone superior to marble.
3. Items of ashlar stone work.
4. Items of false ceiling and its support system.
5. Items of aluminium door/windows/glazing work.
6. Any other item as required in para 7.26.

It is, however, open to the Assistant Engineer/Assistant Executive Engineer to record measurements for any particular item of work himself.

Para 8.7 : The Standard Measurement Books should either be written by the Assistant Engineer/Assistant Executive Engineer himself or by a Junior Engineer under his order. In all cases, the items of works mentioned in para 7.25 shall be measured and recorded by Assistant Engineer/Assistant Executive Engineer himself. Each set of measurements taken by the Junior Engineer should, however, be fully checked by the Assistant Engineer/Assistant Executive Engineer after which it should be examined by the Executive Engineer and declared in writing in the book itself as finally approved by him for the purpose of preparing annual repair estimates and contractor's bills for the work done. Until this is done, the book will not be assigned a number and will not be entered in the register of Standard Measurement Books.

This supersedes all previous orders/amendments issued in this regard.
