SUB: Assistance to Labour Co-operative Societies - Award of Works without Call of Tenders.


The powers given to Officers of CPWD to award works to Registered Labour Co. Operative Societies were last revised vide letter No.28012/24/85-W4 dated 3rd February, 1986 of the Ministry of Urban Development and communicated vide CE/CON/840. The cost index has increased by 216% since then. The Ministry has now conveyed its decision to revise the powers as under:-

Existing powers	Revised powers
1. Award of Minor works upto Rs.50,000	Rs. 2 lacs
2. Award of works at current rates provided the same are within the District Schedule of Rates without call of tenders EE - upto Rs.25,000/- S.E. - upto Rs. 37,500/- CE - upto Rs. 50,000/-	Award of works at current market rates provided the same are certified as reasonable by the officers of CPWD without call of tenders/quotations. EE - upto Rs. 1 lac S.E. - upto Rs. 2 lacs
3. CE will determine and fix "Current Market Rates" every six months for place to place.	Deleted
4. Societies will be exempt from payment of earnest money for works estimated to cost upto the limit of Rs.50,000/-. Societies however will pay security deposits by way of percentage deductions from their bills.	Will be applicable to revised limits.

5. No provision.	The frequency of payment may be fortnightly provided there is appreciable progress on the work and the value of work executed is not less than dRs.20,000/-
